#### **Course Description:**

These courses meet the standards of the American Heart Association for the training of providers in PALS. The goal of these sessions is to integrate knowledge and motor skills into the development of proficiency in the techniques of PALS. The material is covered through videos, discussions, hands-on practice and case scenario simulations. Proficiency in Basic Life Support, Cardiac Rhythm Interpretation, and Pharmacology is required.

### Successful completion of the PALS course consists of adequate performance in the following areas:

- Basic Life Support
- Recognition and treatment of respiratory failure
- Recognition and treatment of cardiopulmonary arrest and dysrhythmias
- Recognition and treatment of shock
- Successful performance as a team leader in 2 pediatric emergency scenarios
- Obtaining a passing score of at least 84% on the written examination

#### Class size is limited. You must present proof of previous certification to gain access to the Renewal Class.

It cannot be emphasized enough that for the greatest success participants need to be well prepared.
