Dear Samaritan Summit Village Assisted Living families,

Late on Wednesday, December 16, Samaritan Health received notice that two additional residents at Samaritan Summit Village Assisted Living facility tested positive for COVID-19.

These two residents were rapid tested and needed a higher level of care. They are now hospitalized.

We also had one staff member in Assisted Living test positive today, Thursday, December 17.

Contact tracing is now being done to determine any other residents or staff that may be impacted. This extends the pause on limited indoor visitation for another 14 days.

Staff continue to be tested weekly and all residents are being closely monitored for symptoms with temperature checks every eight hours. All residents will be routinely COVID tested out of an abundance of caution. We're confident the precautionary measures our staff has been taking – such as isolating residents, masking, eye protection, sanitizing and regular temperature checks – have helped minimize exposure.

We will keep you well informed of any updates regarding COVID-19 testing and results. You will continue to receive a text message or phone call and will be directed to our webpage for all updates: www.samaritanhealth.com/covid-19c. This webpage also contains our COVID Pandemic Emergency Plan for you to review.

If there are ever any health concerns for your family member, Samaritan staff will call you personally. If you have any questions, please contact us directly.
