Dear Samaritan Summit Village Skilled Nursing families,

On Thursday, December 17, Samaritan Health received notice that six staff members of Samaritan Summit Village Skilled Nursing facility tested positive for COVID-19.

As a precaution, all residents are being tested every few days so that we can quickly determine if there are impacted residents. We will continue to closely monitor all residents with vital signs and temperature checks every eight hours. Any staff that may be impacted by this positive case will be contacted and weekly staff testing will continue.

These COVID-19 cases extend our suspension on limited indoor visitation. We must stay COVID free for 14 days for it to resume.

We will keep you informed of any updates regarding positive COVID-19 test results. You will continue to receive a text message or phone call and will be directed to our webpage for all updates: www.samaritanhealth.com/covid-ltc. This webpage also contains our COVID Pandemic Emergency Plan for you to review.
