TREE DECORATOR GUIDELINES

2021 Theme "Merry and Bright"

Decorating Dates

Tuesday, November $16^{\text{th}} 2021 - 9$ a.m. to 9 p.m. Wednesday, November $17^{\text{th}} 2021 - 9$ a.m. to 9 p.m.

**Trees must be completed and forms must be turned in by 7 p.m. on Wednesday, November 17th to be included in the tree judging.

<u>We encourage decorators to pick-up trees early to begin decorating at home</u>. To make arrangements to pick up your tree early, please contact Shawna Cutul@scutuli@nnyymca.org. We encourage all decorators to prepare your decorations ahead of time, as much as possible.

WE WILL ADHER TO ALL NYS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH GUIDELINES AS APPROPRIATE. <u>IF REQUIRED WE</u> <u>WILL MODIFY AS REQUIRED.</u>

Materials and Decorations

As a decorator, please take note of the following to ensure your tree is complete and in compliance of the event:

- The tree and all decorations, lights, and trim on the tree become the property of FESTIVAL OF TREES or the eventual purchaser.
- An 8 foot x 8 foot space is available for each decorator. If you require a larger space, please contact donations@shsny.com, 315-785-5745, or 315-785-4584 with your specific request/need prior to November 8th as our overall space is limited.
- Please do not use living materials or untreated, unwrapped food (no popcorn) on the tree, as they will be displayed in businesses or homes throughout the holiday season, and hopefully for many years to come.
- When decorating with fragile or delicate items such as hydrangea, please remember that your tree will be transported.
- All decorations, lights, and trim MUST BE WIRED OR GLUED to the tree.
- Glue the ornaments to their caps in order to make them more durable for delivery.
- The tree top **must** be secured.
- DO NOT USE GLASS decorations.
- We will have a limited supply of bidding "stands" next to the trees, which will identify your tree name and information. You are welcome to decorate the stand if you would like to match your tree, but please note that if your tree goes to live auction the stand may be disassembled and moved.
- You will receive five sets of white lights for a 7 ft. tree and three for a 4 ft. More lights may be added at your own expense. If adding additional lights, limit the number of strands to two sets per foot. If you have more than 6 strings of lights, you must use a power strip to accommodate the additional lights.

- There will be a limited supply of step ladders available; we encourage you to bring all items necessary to decorate your tree.
- To create a more saleable tree, you may add a special prize(s) or gift item(s) beneath the tree. However, the items placed under the tree become the property of Festival of Trees and the eventual purchaser.
- Designers are responsible for removing litter and garbage before the end of each decorating day.
- Once a tree number is assigned, we cannot accommodate changes, this is critical with this year's event timeline and work required.

Judging

Judging will take place prior to the opening of the event. Award winning tree decorators will be notified. Award winning trees will be highlighted in the program and on the tree signage.

The People's Choice Award will be online and announced once the voting ends. There will be a 4 foot and 7 foot tree award for each of the following categories:

- The Jim Henry Most Whimsical The tree that displays the most whimsy and humor.
- Best Use of Festival Theme Most fittingly presents this year's Festival theme of "Merry and Bright".
- <u>Most Traditional</u> Best characterization of the traditions of Christmas.
- <u>Most Innovative</u> Most unusual and unique use of materials and tree design.
- <u>Judge's Choice</u> A tree that the judges feel is deserving of special recognition (not fitting in to the above categories.)
- <u>Most Elegant</u> Most ornate and sophisticated use of ornaments and decorations.
- <u>People's Choice</u> Recognizes the tree that receives the most votes from the community.

Tree Pricing

- Decorators will receive a tree description and itemized cost sheet to complete and return with their tree to the Festival <u>no later than Wednesday</u>, <u>November 17th at 7:00 p.m.</u> Your tree description and value is very important in order for the committee to properly promote and price your tree. This form helps us market your tree and tell your story!
- Each tree will receive a "Purchase Now Price" unless it is determined to go to live auction.
- If someone wishes to purchase your tree at the "Purchase Now Price" they can pay the set price and the tree will be eliminated from the bidding process.
- Trees sold during the live auction are at the discretion of the Festival of Trees committee.

Decorator Recognition

We love recognizing your hard work! To ensure the program listing and signage next to your tree is complete and accurate, we ask that you provide all details as early as possible.

- The sign next to your tree will include the tree sponsor, the name(s) of the decorator(s), tree name, and design inspiration.
- Names of decorators are listed in the Festival of Trees program and on the auction website.
- Changes to tree decorator names and stories can<u>not be accepted after Wednesday, November 17 at 7:00 p.m.</u>
