



To Samaritan Summit Village Residents and Families:

- September 20, 2021 Update – COVID-19 testing for AL and Skilled staff was completed yesterday and three (3) staff members on the Skilled Nursing side tested positive for COVID-19. All residents on the Skilled side were also tested yesterday and am happy to report that all the residents on the Skilled side tested negative for COVID-19.
- Since our building is connected and there are interactions that happen between staff and residents and per NYS guidelines, we must pause visitation for the entire facility for 14 days. Fence and indoor window visitation are available as alternatives; please contact Dani McLean for Assisted Living visits.
- Please protect yourself by wearing your mask properly when outside of your room and when staff enters your room. Social distance when interacting with other residents and staff. Also, please wash your hands whenever soiled and before leaving and then re-entering your room.
- ANY resident going out of the facility other than for medical appointments and/or testing will need to self-restrict (quarantine) to their room for 10 days if vaccinated or 14 days if not vaccinated. The resident will not be able to participate in activities during this time. Meals will be delivered to the room. COVID-19 testing will be done as per policy.
- Please consider putting off your visits, shopping or unnecessary outings for the next 4-6 weeks.
