




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Clifton-Fine Hospital Visitation

Effective April 8th, 2022

In-Patient Visitation

- 1pm - 5pm 7 days a week.
- Patients may have more than one visitor per day, however **only one person can visit the patient at a time.**
- Be masked during entire visit and remain in patient room.
- Vaccination Status/Negative COVID Test:
 - Visitors must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 (2 doses of Pfizer or Modern 1 dose of J&J) **OR** provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to their visit.
 - Vaccinated visitors must show official proof of vaccination such as an Excelsior Pass, vaccination card, or equivalent proof upon request.
 - Unvaccinated visitors must provide proof of a negative lab test performed 72 hours prior to their visit **OR** must perform their own home test upon arrival to the facility **OR** have a test performed at the facility prior to visiting.

Emergency Department

- **There is no visitation inside the Emergency Department.**
- **One** parent/adult caregiver is permitted to accompany minors under the age of 18.
- **One** Support person may wait in the ED waiting area.

Out-Patient Services (Clinic, Laboratory, Radiology, Rehab Services (PT/OT))

- One parent/adult caregiver is permitted to accompany patients under the age of 18.
- Support Persons/Caregiver will be permitted to accompany the patient to their appointment if the clinical team determines their presence is necessary to the care of the patient.

Visitation Guidelines

- All visitors must be 18 year of age or older
- All Visitors are required to be screened for COVID-19 upon arrival
- All Visitors are expected to wear a MASK at all times
- Visitors will adhere to the CFH ZERO TOLERANCE policy for bullying, harassment and/or abuse of hospital staff regarding these guidelines.
