Visitation Guidelines

- Entrances to building will continue to be limited for security purposes.
- > Visitors must continue to wear a medical mask that fully covers nose and mouth.
- > Please wash your hands before entering & exiting patient room; limit surface touching.
- Visitors MUST follow appropriate PPE use as directed by staff.
- > Visitation will be limited for suspected and/or COVID-19 patients.
- If you are sick, please do not visit CFH can accommodate alternative mechanisms for interactions with patients such as video-call on cell phones or tablets when appropriate.
- Visitation poses a risk to both the visitor and the patient.

In-Patient Visitation

- > Time 10am-12 noon & 1pm-6pm, 7 days a week.
- Patient can have more than one visitor, but no more than two at the bedside at a time.
- > Visitors must be 12 years of age and older.
- Modifications to visitation will be made for imminent end-of-life situations for a patient that is actively dying and death is anticipated within 24 hours.

Emergency Department

- There is no visitation inside the Emergency Department due to clinical safety and privacy concerns.
- > One parent/adult caregiver is permitted to accompany minors under the age of 18.
- > One Support person may wait in the ED waiting area with regular updates from staff.

Out-Patient Services

- > One parent/adult caregiver is permitted to accompany minors under the age of 18.
- > One support person may accompany patient.

DEFINITIONS

- Visitor: an individual, 12 years of age or older.
- Support Person: an individual, 18 years of age or older and are essential to patient care.
