Samaritan will begin construction of a new Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory in the fall of 2025. The new Cardiac Cath Lab will feature Percutaneous Coronary Intervention (PCI) capabilities, allowing for rapid and effective treatment of heart attacks and other cardiovascular conditions.
