Information Needed to Apply

- ERAS Common Application Form
- Curriculum vitae
- Medical School Transcripts
- A minimum of three Letters of Recommendation (must have actively worked with in the last two years or have been a clinical supervisor)
- Personal Statement
- United States Medical Licensing Exam (USMLE) and or Comprehensive Osteopathic Medical Licensing Exam (COMLEX) transcripts, as applicable
- If any required documents are in a language other than English, an English translation of the document must be provided

Requirements

- Actively in medical school or less than four years post-graduation and actively practice in the health care field under a limited training license for at least 12 months in the United States. Outside of the United States, you must be in an active training program.
- Passing score of each of the USMLE or COMLEX by time of interview.
- Be a graduate of a medical school in the United States and Canada accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) or the American Osteopathic Association (AOA).
- Be a graduate of an international medical school and have a currently valid Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) certificate.
- If graduation from medical school has been longer than 4 years, then should have finished or be on track to finish a masters in healthcare prior to the start of residency.
